Each year funding is available through Saskatchewan Lotteries, based on a per capita amount, for the population of the Town of Wawota plus allocations of populations from RM #92 and RM #93. The program is designed to provide funding for sport, culture and recreation programs and is administered through the Wawota Recreation Board.

The Rec. Board then disperses the money to local groups and clubs that have made application for funding for their eligible programs. The fast approaching deadline to apply for the 2016-2017 Community Grant is **February 28, 2016 – NO exceptions.**

CAMPSITE RESERVATION DATES FOR 2016 ANNOUNCED

Campers will be able to book their provincial park campsites beginning Monday, April 11th. The campsite reservation launch, which typically happens in March, has been moved to April for 2016 to avoid overlap with the upcoming provincial election.

As in 2015, the launch will be staggered over a 10-day period, with different parks becoming available for reservations on different days. A queuing system will also be in place again this year to manage the high volume of traffic on the reservation website.

- On average, Canadians spend a third of their lifetime sleeping – 27 years.

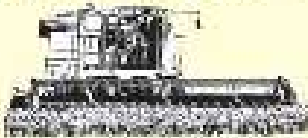

You asked ??

Question: In 2016 February has 29 days. Why add Leap Years?

Answer: Leap years are needed to keep our modern day Gregorian calendar in alignment with the Earth's revolutions around the sun. It takes the Earth approximately 365.242189 days – or 365 days, 5 hours, 48 minutes, and 45 seconds – to circle once around the Sun. This is called a tropical year.

However, the Gregorian calendar has only 365 days in a year, so if we didn't add a leap day on February 29 nearly every four years, we would lose almost six hours off our calendar every year. After only 100 years, our calendar would be off by around 24 days

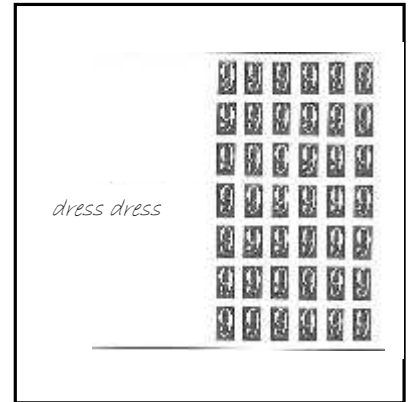
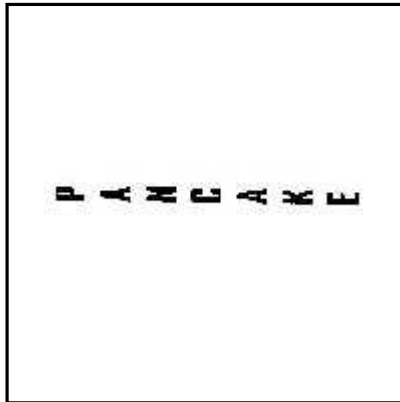
