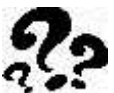

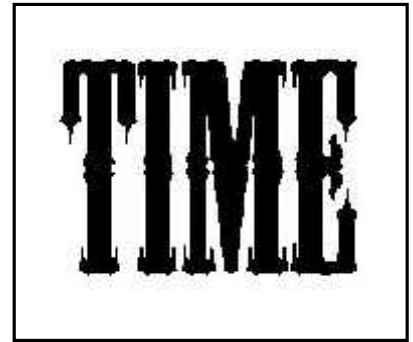
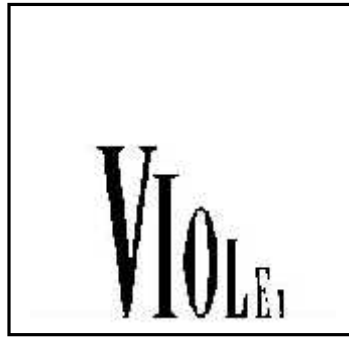

### VIAL OF LIFE ?

Vial of Life is a program that helps emergency personnel locate important medical details in the event of an emergency in the home. A vial containing all important medical information is stored in the refrigerator and a sticker on the fridge door alerts emergency personnel that the vial is inside. (Why the refrigerator? – They are common to every household and can be easily located in an emergency.)



The aim of the Vial of Life program is to help paramedics on the scene of an emergency by reducing the amount of time searching for basic medical and prescription information. Having this information easily accessible will also save time for emergency room and hospital personnel and facilitate the care process. In addition, seniors living alone may not have someone to help communicate important health information to emergency personnel. Someone (doctor, pharmacist, caregiver) could help in the filling out of the form re medications, allergies, doctor's name, next of kin, life support wishes, etc. It is very important the information is kept up to date. If you need a new information sheet for Vial of Life, contact Myrna Sorenson.
