(as we see them)

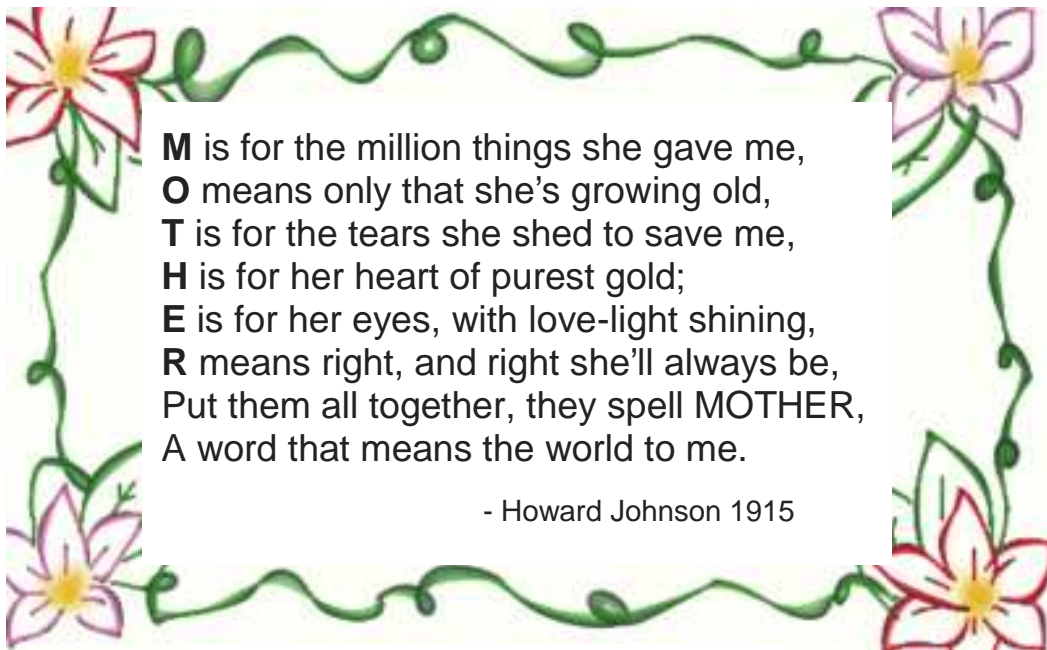

South East Cornerstone Public School Division Update - May 2016

The South East Cornerstone Board of Education made decisions on the future of Pangman and Wapella schools at its board meeting on April 21. The Pangman school community showed very strong support for its school and it will remain open as a K-12 school for the next year. Wapella School, which has not had any students enrolled in Grades 8 and 9 for the last two years, will now become a K-7 school effective the 2016-17 school year. Students in Grades 8-12 will attend McNaughton School in Moosomin. Schools in the division are assessed annually with respect to enrolment numbers that generally determine whether they are placed on review for closure or grade discontinuance.

In addition to K-12 education, the school division also provides Early Learning and Care for students up to the age of 5. While the division took on this responsibility in 2011-12 with 21 students, it now has 115 children (requiring early intervention and home support) on caseload. The program also supports 20 expectant teen moms with educational programming alternatives. As well, the board provides for in-home transitional support for 28 First Nations and Metis vulnerable children that will eventually enroll in its schools.

The Board has approved a partnership with Sask Power and Saskatchewan school divisions which will provide Grade 11 and 12 students with the opportunity to enroll in Power Engineering 20L and Power Engineering 30L starting in September. The program will cost about \$500 per student with 12 seats reserved for SECPSD students. The blended learning model includes 50 hours of work-based hands-on experience at a Sask Power plant and their mobile steam lab training unit, course work through textbooks, and online content through the Prairie South School Division's virtual school. Upon successful completion of the engineering courses, students will have the opportunity to write the Class 5 power engineering examination.

As a result of the June 1 provincial budget date, the board will not be able to finalize its next year's budget until at least the end of June. The Board's next meeting is on May 19 in Weyburn. All regular meetings are open to the public.
