This year we have 36 registered sales (down 3 from last year).





### WANDERING THOUGHTS

(as we see them)

**Here we are once again** – and still battling the **Ws** – wind and worms! One can only wonder if they don't complement each other – there is evidence of the destruction of both wherever we look.

On our travels, we notice dark patches on roads, then realize it's the result of "squished worms – on the move". It's almost difficult to see a lush green stand of trees in the countryside anymore.

In Town, the residences/businesses nearer the Valley seem to have a denser population of the pests – moving into Town from the poplar trees. Spraying may save some trees and destroy some worms, however, they won't be eliminated. One source tells us that by the middle of June should see them move into their next cycle – a cocoon - then a moth!



Last year, we found them on the east side of our house – this year they are more noticeably found on the west side ?? And the sizes – from "thread-thin to little finger". No matter the size, all are treated to a "gasoline cocktail" on our many inspections of house and garage!

A farmer friend tells us that he was doing fence repairs recently and found fence posts (literally black) covered. After lunch (not worms), he found them dead at the bottom of the posts - ??

A shortage of rain is also taking a toll on the agriculture scene. Seeded crops seem to be surviving so far, however hay crops and pastures are beginning to show signs of stress. Reports are that some areas are experiencing the driest spring since 2008.

On the "flip-side" – a Sask Crop Insurance adjuster friend was telling us that he had been working for a couple of weeks in the NE part of the province – his description – "punishment/depressing". Some farmers were trying to combine last year's crop – or burn it – to get it off the fields to enable them to plant this season. (Maybe the worms, wind and shortage of rain aren't so bad.)

Enough gloom and doom! Around town we see mountain ash trees in white bloom (to turn into orange berries come fall). And on the 100 block of Hall Street, the usual four colours of lilacs are always a treat to see. We also see the "new look" at the Skateboard Park – some talented high school girls were commissioned by the Town to get rid of the graffiti sprayed on by some "less intelligent" – looks great!

A friend recently loaned us a copy of the October 14, 1942 issue of the World Spectator (subscription cost of \$1.00 a year). It is very fragile, but still quite readable – extremely interesting – thank you for sharing.

And the Blue Jays success story continues – may it continue!!



### CELEBRATING CANADA'S 150<sup>TH</sup> BY REMEMBERING OUR PAST

(excerpts from pages 208-209 in "A Flight Through Time" Wawota & District History Book) (On Railway Avenue over the years) (some owners over the years listed in parenthesis)

On the corner of Main & Railway was Rowbotham's Hardware (King & Heasman, Heasman & Rowbotham). Tinsmithing & Undertaking – 1936 building burned down. North Star Oil Co. (Garage) then built on this lot (Dallas) with Doctor's Office on 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor. Later years: Les Holloway's Radio Repair Shop, a Tire Shop, Pic-a-Pop, Implement Dealership & Tire Shop (Shorty Beauchesne, Dave Engle, Van Dresars).

Next came the barbershop/pool hall (Bill Chesley, Bill Ward)- this also burned in 1936 and the IOOF Hall was moved to site (Bob Bratton, John Bonar, Mel Vail), then a beauty shop, then a flower shop.


Butcher Shop & Locker Plant was on next lot (several butchers, (lastly Ed Filteau), building was demolished and a Variety Store (Ehikhamen)was built but the building moved off site when store closed.

Next the Dodd Bldg – Dry Goods & Harness (Peddle), then a grocery store (Nelson)- demolished 1983). Next door was the Hardware (W. Bird, McDougall, J.E.D. McCord, Bricker, Corkish Bros.) This building was also demolished.


In 1907 a little building on this next lot housed a bakery, then became the Union Bank, Marshall's ice cream parlor, Bakery (Wilson). Building torn down.

Next came Marshall's Store (1906), confectionary, grocery store (C & E Wilson, Trithart (1961), D & P Jane) with a suite above. Building torn down – hotel has expanded to this lot.

On the corner of Railway & Walter is the Hotel – with many owners over the years (Jersey Crew, Hingston, Nels Meyers, Reiger, Antosh, MacRae, Choicoine, McShannock, Nicurity, Riddell, etc.. The hotel was lifted and turned ¼ turn by Hingston. A section was added to the west in later years.
