PROHIBITED WASTES

- Liquid waste except that which is normally contained in household waste
- Domestic sewage or sludge of any type
- Waste that is burning or likely to cause a fire
- Asbestos materials
- Herbicides, pesticides or hazardous wastes, including the receptacles that contained them
- Biomedical waste
- Explosives
- Radioactive material
- Tires, automobiles or other large metal objects
- Agricultural carcasses
- Materials that exceed the handling capacity of the transfer station equipment or transfer vehicles
- Wastes that may result in excessive dust or odors
- Propane tanks
- Batteries

WAWOTA TRANSFER STATION REGULATIONS

Town of Wawota, RM of Walpole, and RM of Wawken

The Wawota Transfer Station is regulated and inspected regularly by Saskatchewan Environment. Should an inspection find the Town is not following these regulations the site can be closed and fines could also be imposed. Please help us to keep it operating.

The person attending the gate is required to determine what items are coming to the site, if a fee is required, and which municipality the items are coming from.

All users will sign their name on the sheet, **print** and **sign** their name, state the municipality they reside or own property, and write in the amount they are paying. If they refuse to do this; they cannot leave waste at the facility.

R.M. of WALPOLE #92 and **R.M. of WAWKEN #93** residents or landowners will dispose their waste in a shared designated bin. **TOWN OF WAWOTA** residents or landowners will dispose their waste in its own designated bin.

Burnable Items – Clean Wood and Tree Limbs are the only items that are considered burnable – No Charge

Compost Items – Leaves, garden waste or grass clippings. These items **MUST** be removed from the bags when being placed in the compost pile – No Charge

Gate Fees are payable before the waste is dumped. Cheques are to be made out to the Town of Wawota. Receipts are available as requested.
