## Fall Recipe

### Corn Chowder Soup

4 slices diced bacon  
1 medium onion, chopped  
1 can creamed corn  
1½ cups raw potatoes, diced  
1 can cream of mushroom soup  
3 cups milk  
½ tsp salt  
1/8 tsp pepper



Saute bacon and onion, until onion is translucent. Add remaining ingredients and bring to a boil. Cover and simmer until potatoes are cooked.

### Canned Tomatoes

Per Quart:

Blanche tomatoes and peel off skin.  
Put in quart to ¾ full.

Add: 1 tsp sugar  
½ tsp pickling salt



Fill last ¼ of jar with tomato juice.  
Seal.

Put in canner and cook 20 minutes. Cool, label and store.

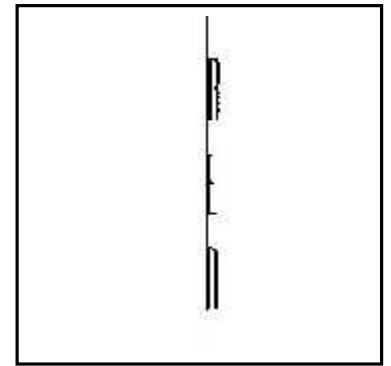
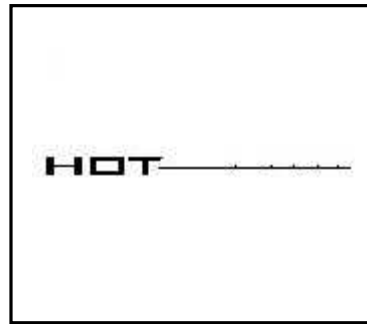
