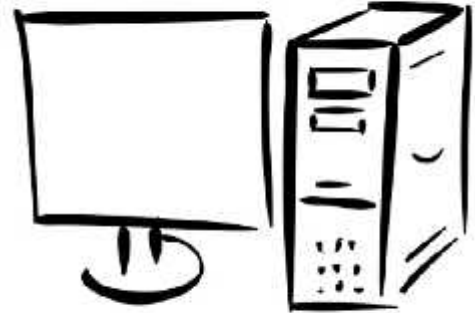

## OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD SHOE BOX PROJECT

**School Supplies:** exercise books or note books; pencils, pens, crayons, erasers, pencil sharpeners, calculators, pencil cases.

**Hygiene:** Toothbrushes, combs, tissues, sanitary pads, unscented soap, face cloths or small towel.

**Play:** skipping ropes, balls, stuffed animals, cars, trucks, balloons, tops, marbles, small dominos, harmonica or other instruments, stickers, frisbees, sewing kits.

**Clothing:** flip flops, hats, t-shirts, toques, sox, scarves, underwear (new), shorts, dresses, ball caps.

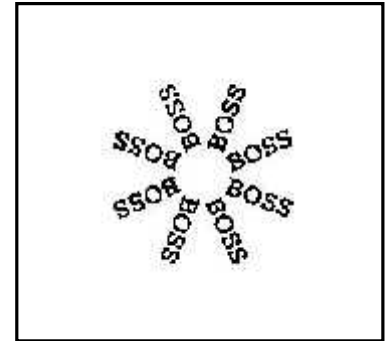
