## SYMBOLS OF CHRISTMAS

**Fir Tree:** always green – everlasting light and life – branches pointing up towards the heavens.

**Star:** symbolizes the star of Bethlehem which guided the way to the baby Jesus.

**Bells:** announcing the birth of the Christ child.

**Candle:** A mirror of starlight, reflecting our thanks for the star of Bethlehem – Jesus the light of the world.

**Gift Bow:** ribbon is tied to represent how we should all be tied together in bonds of goodwill.

**Candy Cane:** is the shape of the shepherd's crook, Jesus the Good Shepherd was born on Christmas day and the crook brings the lost lambs back to the fold. The red stripe represents Christ's sacrifice and the white stands for His purity. Three red stripes – The Father, Son & Holy Ghost.

**Wreath:** A circular, never-ending symbol of eternal love and rebirth.

## VIAL OF LIFE ?

Vial of Life is a program that helps emergency personnel locate important medical details in the event of an emergency in the home. A vial containing all important medical information is stored in the refrigerator and a sticker on the fridge door alerts emergency personnel that the vial is inside. (Why the refrigerator? – They are common to every household and can be easily located in an emergency.)



The aim of the Vial of Life program is to help paramedics on the scene of an emergency by reducing the amount of time searching for basic medical and prescription information. Having this information easily accessible will also save time for emergency room and hospital personnel and facilitate the care process. In addition, seniors living alone may not have someone to help communicate important health information to emergency personnel. Someone (doctor, pharmacist, caregiver) could help in the filling out of the form re medications, allergies, doctor's name, next of kin, life support wishes, etc. It is very important the information is kept up to date.

This is a community service – free of charge – a project of the United Church Pastoral Care Committee. For more information, contact Myrna Sorenson 306-739-2823.

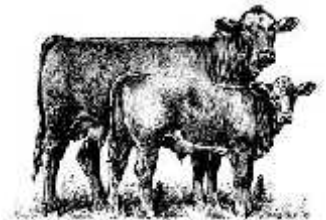

## SUPER MOON

Did you get a chance to see the Super Moon last Sunday night? Skywatchers were treated to the only *super moon* in 2017. When there was a break in the clouds, you might have noticed that the Moon was especially large and bright. The reason – because the moon was at its closest distance to Earth.



The perigee moon (prerequisite for a *super moon*) exists because as the moon orbits the Earth it does so in an oval or elliptical shape, meaning sometimes the moon is closer to the Earth and other times it's farther. For a super moon to exist, there must both be a full moon as well as a perigee moon, that was why the moon looked especially close, full, and bright.

The most recent super moon was around a year ago on November 14, 2016. However, 2018 will delight skywatchers with two super moons, one on January 2nd and another just a few weeks later on January 31st. The super moon on January 31st will also be a blue moon as it is the second full moon in the same month. NASA has named this the super moon trilogy, with three super moons occurring in just a few month timespan.
