## **CRANBERRY-ORANGE MUFFINS**

1/2 cup milk <i>whole milk recommended</i>	
1 1/2 tsp lemon juice	
2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour	
4 tsp baking powder	Zest of one orange ( 1 Tbsp)
1/2 tsp fine table salt	1 tsp vanilla
1/2 cup vegetable oil	1/4 cup freshly squeezed
1 1/4 cups white sugar	orange juice
2 large eggs	1 1/2 cups fresh or frozen
	cranberries

Topping – Granulated Sugar

Preheat oven to 425 [F. Spray a 12 cup muffin tray with baking spray or line with paper liners. Set aside. Add lemon juice to milk. Stir and let stand 5 minutes. In a large bowl, whisk together well the flour, baking powder and salt. (\*If using frozen cranberries, do not thaw. Toss with 1 tsp flour before adding to batter. Starting with frozen cranberries will add 5-8 minutes to your baking time.) In a medium bowl, whisk together the milk/lemon juice, the vegetable oil, sugar, eggs, orange juice, vanilla and orange zest. Add the wet mixture to the dry ingredients, mixing just until combined and no flour is visible. Fold in the cranberries. Sprinkle tops generously with sugar. Bake at 425 [F for 5 minutes, then reduce the oven temp to 375 [F and bake for another 13-16 minutes if you started with fresh cranberries or 18-22 minutes if you started with frozen cranberries. Bake until lightly golden and a tester inserted in the middle comes out clean.
