

TOWN OF WAWOTA

BYLAW NO. 3/2005

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE RAISING OF RATS OR REPTILES AS
COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF
WAWOTA.


The Council of the Town of Wawota, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall keep, harbour or raise any "domestic" rats or other rats of the Genus Rattus as a commercial enterprise within the boundaries of the Town of Wawota.
2. No person shall keep, harbour or raise reptiles as a commercial enterprise within the boundaries of the Town of Wawota.
3. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Wawota.
