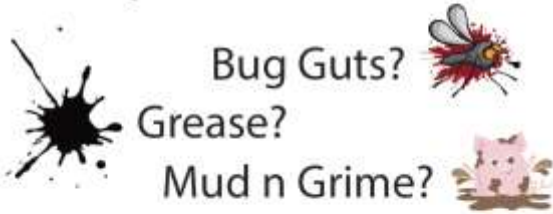

Also saw what “used to be” an evergreen shelterbelt at the same farm.

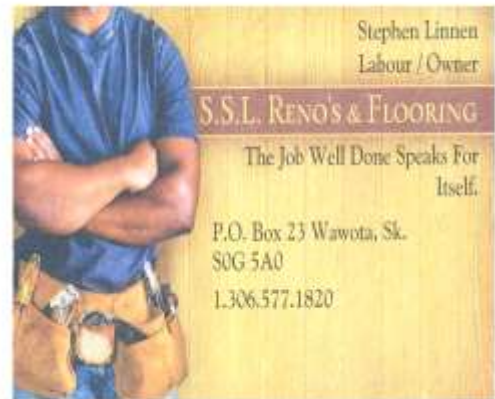
The storm also caused the deaths of two 18 year olds from Melita whose car was caught in the path.
