

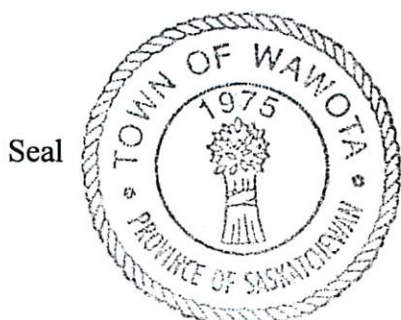


**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR FIRE PROTECTIVE SERVICES
COST RECOVERY**

The Council of the Town of Wawota in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows

1. In this Bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Wawota; and
 - d) "Fire Response" shall mean any response by:
 - i) WWW Fire Protection District.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the person(s) who receive the service in accordance with:
 - a) The current rates as charged from the responding fire service as determined by the WWW Fire Protection District which is subject to change.
3. The Council hereby authorizes the Administrator to invoice the ratepayer(s) for the cost of the fire protection services promptly following the date the service was received and the invoiced fees shall be payable directly to the Town of Wawota.
4. The Council hereby authorizes the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property (land, improvement or business) owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this Bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year. At calendar year, the fire protection services will become part of taxes and be subject to penalty.
5. All funds relating to fire protective services, collected by the Administrator, shall be forwarded on to the WWW Fire Protection District.
6. No person shall refuse fire service.






